Concert de Noël / Christmas Concert

We will be holding our Christmas Concert for all four classes on Wednesdsay, December 18th at 6:30pm in Campbelltown School gym (271 Conifer Street) and NOT at Sherwood Heights School. Parents are expected to attend with their child. The children have already begun to learn their songs and dances and are having a great time doing so. Please bring your child to the school for 6:15pm. Due to the size of the gym, each family will have a limit of 4 tickets, for 4 guests to attend. Your preschool child does NOT require a ticket. If necessary, we can help families acquire an extra ticket each, especially if immediate family size is 6, and thus 4 tickets doesn't even allow for the siblings and parents to attend. If you have extra tickets that you won't be using or you have 2 children in our preschool and thus receive 8 tickets, please hand extras back to your teacher so we can redistribute them to those really in need. Please note that, due to fire code regulations, every guest (including small children and infants in car seats) must have a ticket. Please let us know as soon as possible if your child will not be attending the concert. Christmas concert tickets will be distributed the week of December 9th.

Each child will require some props for the concert. As soon as possible, and by December 9th at the latest, please send the following to school:


- A small Christmas gift bag (not for wine), clearly labeled with your child's name, and inside the bag:
